THE PALESTRA GAME

Penn State makes its return to the historic Palestra Sunday when the Nittany Lions play host to Indiana in the City of Brotherly Love.	
Penn State has hosted four Big Ten games inside the "Cathedral of College Basketball", defeating Michigan State in 2017, Iowa in 2020, and most recently Michigan in 2024. Penn State has played 62 total games in The Palestra dating back to 1927.	
The 2024-25 Nittany Lion roster features two student-athletes with Philadelphia-area ties in Zach Hicks (Camden, N.J.; Camden Catholic) and Kachi Nzeh (Upper Darby, Pa.; George School).

PHILLY PHILLY	
The Philly to Penn State pipeline runs deep. Since Penn State first moved a Big Ten game to the Palestra in 2017, the Palestra game has always been meant as a homecoming game for Penn State's Philadelphia-area players.

The Nittany Lions are off to a 12-2 start to the season, their best record through the first 14 games of the season since the 2019-20 campaign.	
Should Penn State beat Indiana on Sunday, the Nittany Lions' 13-2 start would be their best start since the 1995-96 team started 14-1. Penn State would also start Big Ten play 3-1, its best start to BIG action since that same 1995-96 team began 4-0.	
The Nittany Lions rank top 15 in the country in points per game (87.9 - 7th), turnovers forced per game (17.14 - 8th), assists per game (18.4 - 11th), turnover margin (5.4 - 13th) and scoring margin (+20.0 - 14th).	

REWRITING HISTORY...ALREADY

The Nittany Lions have accomplished the following Penn State milestones through just the first 14 games of the season:

Finished non-conference play at 10-1, marking just the sixth time since Penn State joined the Big Ten in 1992-93 that the Nittany Lions have finished regular-season non-conference action with one or fewer losses.

Big Ten-opening win over #8 Purdue was Penn State's first win over a team ranked in the top 10 of the AP Poll since Dec. 2019.

Started the season 6-0 for the first time in 25 years (since the 1999-2000 season).

Started the season 8-1 for the first time in 10 years (since the 2014-15 season).

Scored 100+ points in back-to-back games for the first time in program history (108 vs. Binghamton, 103 vs. UMBC).

Scored 80+ points in six-consecutive games for the first time in program history.

Scored 100+ in three games in the same season for just the second time in program history. The 1954-55 team scored 100+ on three occasions.

### HIGH OCTANE

Penn State is averaging 87.9 points per game, a mark that ranks seventh in the country.

The Nittany Lions have scored 80-plus points in 11 of their 14 games this season.

DOMINATION

Penn State is outscoring its opponents by an average of 20.0 points per game, a mark that ranks 14th in all of Division I. Eleven of Penn State's 12 wins have been double-digit victories. The Nittany Lions own three 40-plus point victories this season.

Penn State has played 560 minutes of basketball this season and trailed for just 97 minutes and 6 seconds.

BALANCED ATTACK

Five different Penn State players are averaging double-digit points: Ace Baldwin Jr. (15.0 ppg), Yanic Konan Niederhauser (13.1 ppg), Zach Hicks (12.6 ppg), Nick Kern Jr. (11.6 ppg) and Puff Johnson (10.6 ppg), with Freddie Dilione V nearly reaching the double-digit mark (9.9 ppg).

Nine players have scored in double figures, with five different players recording 20-plus point games, in the Nittany Lions' balanced offensive attack.

TURNING DEFENSE INTO OFFENSE

Penn State ranks eighth in Division I in turnovers forced per game (17.14) and 18th in steals per game (10.0). The Nittany Lions have owned a 294-153 advantage in points scored off turnovers through the first 14 games of the season.

ONE OF ONE

Graduate student Ace Baldwin Jr. is the ONLY active Division I player and one of just nine Division I players since the 1947-48 season (77 years) with 1,500+ career points (1,507), 700+ career assists (737) and 300+ career steals (303).

He is on track to break into the top 30 in NCAA's all-time career steals leaders this season as #30 on the all-time list sits at 321 career steals.

Baldwin Jr. is Division I's active career leader in steals (303) and his 737 career assists are second amongst active Division I players.

GOT AN ACE UP OUR SLEEVE

Ace Baldwin Jr. currently ranks fourth in the country with his 8.5 assists per game and sixth in free throw percentage (94.4%). He is averaging stellar marks of 15.0 points, 8.5 assists, 2.9 rebounds and 2.3 steals per game. He's notched five points-assists double-doubles and has tallied double-digit assists in more games (6) than he did all of last season (4), including a single-game school record 16 helpers on Dec. 14 vs. Coppin State.

The reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, Baldwin Jr. earned a spot on the Naismith Trophy Men's College Player of the Year Watch List this preseason, in addition landing on the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List and being named a Preseason All-Big Ten selection.

BIG FELLA BURSTING ONTO THE SCENE

Yanic Konan Niederhauser, Penn State's mobile and versatile seven-foot forward, is averaging 13.1 points and team-best marks of 6.8 rebounds and 1.9 blocks per game. The Switzerland native transferred to Penn State ahead of the 2024-25 season following two years at Northern Illinois.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING INDIANA

- The Hoosiers are 11-3 on the season, 2-1 in Big Ten play, and ride a three-game win streak into Sunday's matchup at The Palestra.
- Indiana's two Big Ten wins both came at home as the Hoosiers picked up an 82-67 win over Minnesota on Dec. 9 and an 84-74 victory over Rutgers in their most recent game on Thursday night. The Hoosiers' conference loss came on Dec. 13 as Indiana fell 85-68 at Nebraska.
- Malik Reneau leads four Hoosiers in double figures with 14.1 points per game. Mackenzie Mgbako follows with 13.6, while Oumar Ballo is averaging 12.8 points and a team-best 9.4 rebounds per game. Myles Rice contributes 12.2 points per game.

AGAINST THE HOOSIERS

- Penn State and Indiana meet for the first of two times this regular season Sunday afternoon at The Palestra.
- The Nittany Lions have won four of the last five meetings with the Hoosiers. Penn State swept the regular-season series over Indiana a season ago, marking just the second time in program history and the first time since 2009 that the Nittany Lions swept the Hoosiers.
- The two teams met in the second round of the 2024 Big Ten Tournament on March 14, with Indiana claiming a 61-59 win.

ZACH ATTACK

Senior Zach Hicks leads the Big Ten in 3-point shooting percentage (44.7%) and ranks second in 3-pointers made per game (2.71).

KERN COMING ON

Senior Nick Kern Jr. has scored in 10 of the last 11 games. He has shot 66.3 percent (70-110) from the field this season while averaging 11.6 points, 4.8 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.4 steals per game.

CONSISTENCY

Puff Johnson has been a consistent threat for the Nittany Lions this season, averaging career-best marks of 10.6 points and 4.6 rebounds per game while shooting 54.1% from the field. He's already tallied more double-digit scoring games this season (8) than all of last year (7).

Rhoades is in his 21st season as a head coach and owns a 401-208 career record, a .658 winning percentage, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

FUTURE LOOKS BRIGHT

Head Coach Mike Rhoades has inked the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and the 21st-ranked class in the country as three highly-touted prospects signed to join the Nittany Lions during the November early signing period.

Penn State's three-member class ranks 21st in the nation per 247 Sports. The three-member class is comprised of Mason Blackwood (Rochester, N.Y.), Justin Houser (Camp Hill, Pa.) and Kayden Mingo (Farmingdale, N.Y.). Mingo, a consensus top-50 prospect, is the highest-ranked recruit in program history.

The three new Nittany Lions join the program as the Class of 2029 and bring accomplished athletic and academic pedigrees to Penn State.

## PENN STATE AT THE PALESTRA

The historic Palestra, on the University of Pennsylvania campus in Philadelphia, opened on Jan. 1, 1927. The Palestra has hosted more games, more visiting teams and more NCAA tournaments than any other facility in college basketball. At the time of its construction, it was one of the world's largest arenas.

Penn State played its first game at the Palestra on Jan. 27, 1927, less than a month after the building's opening.

Rec Hall, the longtime home for Penn State basketball, was designed by the same architect, Charles Klauder, responsible for The Palestra. The groundbreaking for Rec Hall started in January 1927 and opened two years after The Palestra, in January 1929.

The Nittany Lions have a 25-37 record when playing in the Palestra with a 15-9 mark in games played vs. teams other than Penn. Penn State has won five of its last six contests in The Palestra and 14 of its last 22 games played in the historic venue.

The Penn State-Michigan State matchup in 2017 was the first regular-season league game to take place in the City of Brotherly Love, with the Nittany Lions earning a 72-63 win. The #21 Nittany Lions took down #23 Iowa in a thriller on Jan. 4, 2020. Penn State held a 37-31 halftime lead over #1 Purdue Jan. 8, 2023, but the top-ranked Boilermakers battled back for a 76-63 win. The Nittany Lions battled back from a 14-point deficit to top Michigan, 79-73, in their most recent game at The Palestra on Jan. 7, 2024.

Sunday's game will count as an alternate-site home game for Penn State and will be counted as a Nittany Lion home game in the NET rankings calculations.



The Nittany Lions will be playing their fifth Big Ten game inside the "Cathedral of College Basketball".

## NOTABLE PENN STATE GAMES IN THE PALESTRA

**1953-54:** Led by standouts Jack Sherry and Jesse Arnelle, the Nittany Lions upended the Quakers, 72-67, on Dec. 12, 1953 for their first win vs. Pennsylvania since the 1938-39 season. The victory kicked off a memorable season in which PSU reached its first and only Final Four.

**1961-62:** Senior captain Gene Harris scored 46 points, which still stands as the Penn State single-game scoring record, in the second game of the first annual Quaker City Classic.

**1988-89:** The Nittany Lions earned their first 20-win season in more than 20 years in 1988-89, highlighted by a run to the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game. Led by junior center Ed Fogell, who scored a career-high 28 points, Penn State routed West Virginia 86-64.

**1990-91:** Playing its final season in the Atlantic 10, the Nittany Lions went out with a run to the conference tournament title and their first NCAA Tournament bid in 25 years. No. 3 seed Penn State's quarterfinal and semifinal wins both came at the Palestra

**2008-09:** An early highlight of one of the most memorable Nittany Lion seasons came when Penn State visited the Palestra to play Pennsylvania in November in which the Nittany Lions took home an 85-73 victory. Stanley Pringle and Talor Battle combined for 49 points and were 8-for-15 from 3-point range.

**2015-16:** After trailing in the first half, 32-15, Penn State battled back for a 63-57 comeback win over Drexel. On the strength of Payton Banks' game-high 20 points, the 17-point comeback marked one of the largest come-from-behind victories in Penn State history.

**2016-17:** In only the second Big Ten home game played at a neutral site, Penn State fans packed the Palestra on a snowy afternoon and watched the Nittany Lions roll to a 44-32 halftime lead. The squad's Philadelphia natives scored 55 of PSU's 72 points en route to the 72-63 "homecoming" win and the first victory over the Spartans since 2011.

**2019-20:** In a game that saw 24 lead changes and 10 ties, No. 21 Penn State defeated No. 23 Iowa 89-86 in a steamy Palestra on a nearly 70-degree day in early January. The Nittany Lions surged in the final 4:37 behind the energy in the building, going 5-5 from the floor in the final minutes to secure their fifth-straight win.

**2023-24:** Penn State battled back from a 14-point deficit to rally for a 79-73 win over Michigan on Jan. 7, 2024. Penn State used a 19-5 second-half run to erase what was a 14-point Wolverine lead. D'Marco Dunn sparked the streak with eight-straight points, and his triple with 11:36 to play gave Penn State its first lead of the game, a lead the Nittany Lions wouldn't relinquish.

## PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

## MIKE RHOADES

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his second season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2024-25. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 389-206 record, a winning percentage of .654, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a first-year head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24. Rhoades developed and mentored the 2024 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year in Ace Baldwin Jr. and four All-Big Ten selections in Baldwin Jr., Qudus Wahab, Nick Kern Jr. and Zach Hicks.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

The Rams won both the Atlantic 10 regular-season and tournament championships during the 2022-23 season, making their third NCAA Tournament appearance under Rhoades and finishing 27-8 overall. The Rams' 27 wins were the most under Rhoades and the most for VCU since the 2012-13 season. Rhoades mentored VCU junior point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to Atlantic 10 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year honors in the 2022-23 season.

In just his second season in 2018-19, Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament, as well as their first Atlantic 10 Conference outright regular-season championship. VCU's 25 total wins, including 16 conference victories, tied program regular-season marks. For his efforts, he was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 following a 19-7 campaign in which the Black and Gold reached the A-10 Championship Game.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice. VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons. He was named ODAC Coach of the Year in three-straight seasons from 2001-03, coached three ODAC Players of the Year, five ODAC Freshmen of the Year, as well as 17 All-ODAC selections. He began his coaching career at age 23 as an assistant at Randolph-Macon in 1996 under long-time head coach Hal Nunnally.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.

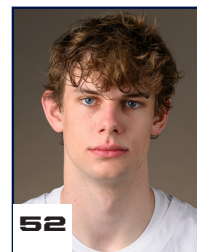

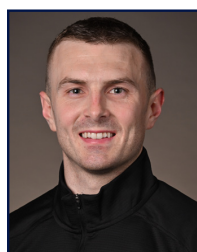
