San Diego State vs. Wyoming Postgame Notes

Big Notes

- San Diego State has secured a bye into the quarterfinal round of the Mountain West Tournament for the 19th time in the last 20 and for the eighth straight season.
- SDSU has now won nine of its last 11 games.
- San Diego State was limited to 23 rebounds. It is the fourth time under Brian Dutcher the Aztecs were limited to 23 or fewer boards, but it has a 3-1 record in those games.
- The Aztecs held an opponent to under 30.0 percent shooting from beyond the arc for the 15th time this season.
- San Diego State wins at least 20 games in a season in each of Brian Dutcher's eight seasons as head coach.
- The Aztecs won their 17th consecutive game when leading with five minutes to play.
- In its last two road games, SDSU is shooting 47.0 percent from the field (47-for-100).
- San Diego State defeats Wyoming for the 13th straight time, regardless of location, extending its current longest active win streak against a Mountain West opponent. Wyoming has not defeated San Diego State since December 27, 2017.

Series Notes

- The Aztecs are now 53-41 in the all-time series, including 14-23 at Arena-Auditorium.
- SDSU is 35-17 against Wyoming in the Mountain West era (since the start of the 1999-00 season).
- San Diego State has defeated the Cowboys for the 13th consecutive time, regardless of location, and fourth in a row at Arena-Auditorium.
- Head coach Brian Dutcher is now 13-1 against Wyoming, including 4-1 at Arena-Auditorium.

Team Notes

- In road games, the Aztecs are now:
 - 51-34 under Brian Dutcher
 - 65-40 versus Mountain West teams since the start of the 2013-14 season, when the current slate of teams came together.
 - 107-58 in its last 165 games against unranked opponents, including a 49-31 mark under Brian Dutcher.
- San Diego State in 8-5 on Saturday's this season, 111-52 in its last 163 games played on the day, including 57-28 under Brian Dutcher.
- In games played in the month of February, the Aztecs are now 49-12 under Brian Dutcher and as a program is 76-25 in its last 101 February tilts.
- When San Diego State scores the first points of a game, it is now 128-26 in the Brian Dutcher era and 246-62 in its last 308 games.
- SDSU stands at 4-6 this season, 29-45 under Brian Dutcher, and 60-86 since the start of the 2010-11 season when its opponent takes a lead into the intermission.
- The Aztecs improve to 16-0 in 2024-25, 172-12 under Brian Dutcher, and 428-16 in their last 444 contests in which they have a lead with five minutes to play.
- SDSU stands at 46-48 under Brian Dutcher, including 7-6 this year, and 86-78 in the last 164 when it loses the battle on the boards.
- San Diego State moves to 12-2 this season, 133-32 under Brian Dutcher and 177-13 in the last 210 when it forces more turnovers than it commits.
- San Diego State attempted more free throws than its opponent and improve to 8-1 this season, 126-9 under Brian Dutcher and 264-34 in its last 298.
- The Aztecs are 19-2 this season, 162-13 under Brian Dutcher and 325-23 in their last 348 when outshooting their opponent.

Game Flow

- **Lead Changes: 14 | Ties: 8**
- Wyoming won the tip.
- San Diego State's Miles Byrd hit the games first bucket, a jumper, at 19:45.
- SDSU started the game 4-of-5 and used a 7-0 run to take a 9-4 lead with 15:59 to go.
- After hitting its first two shots in the first 2:11, Wyoming went 1-of-10 from the floor over the next 5:53.
- SDSU scored 10 of its first 14 points in the paint.
- San Diego State had only one field goal in the last 6:03 of the first half.
- In the first half, SDSU was beaten on the glass 22-to-8, including 9-to-1 on the offensive glass.
- There were seven tied and seven lead changes in the first half.
- There were three technical fouls assessed in the first 4:42 of the second half.
- Wyoming was in the bonus for the final 12:58 of the second half.
- SDSU used an 8-0 run over 1:53 in the second half to turn a 51-48 deficit into a 56-51 lead.
- SDSU was in the bonus for the final 8:54 of the second half.
- With San Diego State leading 58-54 with 6:58 to play Wyoming took its last timeout.

Player Notes

BJ Davis – 18 points, 5-of-8 FG, 4-of-7 3PFG, 4-of-5 FT, 4 rebounds, 3 steals, 1 assist

Scored in double figures for the 13th time this season and in his career ... Led the team in scoring for the fourth time this season and of his career (SDSU is 3-1 in those games) ... Has scored in double figures in two of the last three games ... Matched his career-best with four 3-pointers ... Shot at least 62.5 percent for the sixth time this year (SDSU is 5-1 in those games) ... Over the last three games, is averaging 12.7 points and shooting 61.1 percent from the field (11-of-18) including 62.5 percent from the bonus distance (10-of-16).

Miles Byrd – 18 points, 7-of-14 FG, 1-of-5 3PFG, 3-of-4 FT, 2 rebounds, 3 assists, 2 steals

Scored in double figures for the 18th time this season and 20th time in his career (SDSU is 14-6) ... Led the team in scoring for the ninth time this season and of his career ... SDSU is 8-0 this season and 20-3 for his career when he shoots at least 50.0 percent from the floor ... Committed one or fewer turnovers for the 44th time in 64 career games.

Jared Coleman-Jones – 12 points, 5-of-11 FG, 1-of-3 3PFG, 5 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 steal

Scored in double figures for the seventh time this season (SDSU is 6-1) and 28th time of his career ... Has recorded back-to-back double-figure scoring games for the first time since January 28 vs. San Jose State & February 1 versus Wyoming.

Other Aztecs of Note

Miles Heide

Went 3-of-3 from the field ... In the last two games, both starts, is 8-of-10 (80.0 percent) from the floor.

Nick Boyd

Led the team with six assists . . . In his last four games he has assisted on 25 buckets (6.3 assists per game).
