### **[4] San Diego State vs. [2] Wyoming Postgame Notes**

## **Final Score: San Diego State 72, Wyoming 68**

### **Big Notes**

- San Diego State won its first Mountain West Tournament under Stacie Terry-Hutson.
- This was the Aztecs' first MW Tournament title since 2012 and third overall (also 2010).
- SDSU now has five conference tournament titles in program history (1994 and 1997 while in WAC, 2010, 2012 and 2025 while in MW).
- San Diego State will find out Sunday at 5 p.m. PT where it will play in its 10th NCAA tournament and first since 2012.
- The Aztecs have 25 victories in a season for the first time since winning a school-record 27 in the 2012-13 season.
- SDSU now has six seasons with at least 25 victories (also 1980-81, 1988-89, 1993-94, 2011-12 and 2012-13).
- San Diego State's 70 victories over the last three seasons match its most in a three-season span in school history (also 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96).
- The Aztecs won their eighth straight game and now have wins in 11 of their last 13.

### **Mountain West Tournament Notes**

- San Diego State improved to 24-23 all-time in the Mountain West Tournament.
- The Aztecs are now 3-4 in the MW Championship game.
- San Diego State is now 5-8 against the No. 2 seed.
- The Aztecs improved to 5-2 all-time against Wyoming in the MW Tournament.
- SDSU improved to 3-3 in overtime games in the MW Tournament.
- This is the first Division I Conference Tournament Final to have three-plus overtimes since the 2013 SWAC Final went four overtimes (Prairie View A&M over MVSU).

- San Diego State played in back-to-back championship games for the first time since 2011-12 and 2012-13.

### **Series Notes**

- San Diego State improved to 32-39 all-time against Wyoming.
- The Aztecs are now 6-2 all-time against the Cowgirls on neutral courts.
- SDSU improved to 5-2 all-time against Wyoming in the MW Tournament.

### **Team Notes**

- SDSU improved to 4-1 on the season in neutral games.
- San Diego State improved to 11-3 in night games (5 p.m. or later).
- SDSU is now 2-1 on the season in overtime games.
- The Aztecs improved to 9-8 when trailing at the end of the first quarter.
- SDSU improved to 4-9 when trailing at the end of the third quarter.
- San Diego State is now 4-9 on the season when trailing with 5 minutes remaining in regulation.
- The Aztecs improved to 6-2 in games decided by five points or less.
- SDSU improved to 18-2 when holding its opponent to under 40 percent shooting from the floor.
- San Diego State improved to 19-3 when outshooting its opponent.
- The Aztecs improved to 17-1 when making more free throws than their opponent.
- SDSU is now 18-3 when outrebounding its opponent.
- San Diego State improved to 19-3 when having more steals than its opponent.
- The Aztecs are now 18-3 when having more points in the paint.

### **Game Flow**

- **Lead Changes: 16 | Ties: 12**
- Wyoming won the tip.
- San Diego State's Cali Clark made the first basket of the game, a lay-up 1:39 into the first quarter.

### **Player Notes**

#### **Veronica Sheffey – 24 points, 9-10 FT, 6 rebounds, 5 assists, 2 steals**

Scored a career-high 24 points ... Reached double digits in points for the 21st time this season (SDSU is 15-6) and for the 45th time of her career ... Led the team in scoring for the 13th time this season ... Was named the tournament MVP and named to the all-tournament team.

#### **Naomi Panganiban – 17 points, 1 rebound, 3 assists, 1 steal**

Scored in double figures for the 16th time this season (and career) ... SDSU is now 14-2 when she scores in double figures ... Was named to the all-tournament team.

#### **Cali Clark – 12 points, 6-10 FG, 17 rebounds, 3 blocks, 2 assists, 6 steals**

Logged her seventh double-double of the season (SDSU is 5-2) and career ... Scored in double figures for the ninth time this season (SDSU is 7-2) and 21st time of her career (her teams are 18-3) ... Reached double figures in rebounding for the 11th time this season (San Diego State is 8-3) and 19th time of her career (her teams are 13-6) ... Led the team in rebounding for the 23rd time of the season ... Her 17 rebounds are the most by an Aztec in a Mountain West Tournament game, eclipsing Mallory Adams' 16 vs. New Mexico on March 11, 2019 ... Became the first Aztec since at least 1999-00 to record at least 10 points, 15 rebounds and 5 steals against a Division I opponent (second time regardless of opponent) ... Also became the first player in Mountain West history to have a game with at least 15 rebounds, six steals and two blocks ... Became the only Division I player this century to have a conference tournament game with at least 17 rebounds, six steals and three blocks.

#### **Kim Villalobos – 11 points, 9 rebounds, 1 block, 1 assist, 4 steals**

Scored in double figures for the 16th time this season (SDSU is 13-3) and for the 64th time of her career (SDSU is 42-22).
